

## End Semester Examinations, May 2022

### RESULT NOTIFICATION

BA/BSc 2nd, 4th, 6th Semesters

The provisional results of the End Semester Examinations (ESE), May 2022, for BA/BSc are hereby declared.

#### **Issue of mark sheets** (*for those who have finished BA/BSc programme*)

1. Original mark sheets (along with other relevant exam documents) for those who have finished BA/BSc programmes will be issued from 23 June 2022 onwards from the exam section during office hours.
2. A regular BA/BSc 6th Semester student is to submit the following while collecting the mark sheet:
  - (a) Clearance certificate from the Librarian
  - (b) A photocopy of his/her bank passbook clearly showing the bank details
3. A repeater is to submit the old mark sheet(s) of the arrear paper(s). Additionally, a repeater of BA/BSc 2nd/4th semester who have been declared passed in BA/BSc having cleared all six semesters is to submit the old BA/BSc 6th Semester mark sheet and pay ₹150/- for the new one.
4. For students who have been declared passed in BA/BSc having cleared all six semesters, provisional pass certificates will be issued by the college.
5. Any document has to be collected in person by the respective student and no request/authorisation letter will be entertained.

#### **Correction of mark sheets** (*for those being issued*)

While all care has been taken to ensure accuracy in the results published, errors, if any, will be rectified as per the examination rules and regulations of the college. Any mistake in the mark sheet must be reported to the college exam section by 25 July 2022, after which due fees will be charged for any necessary correction.

#### **Revaluation**

1. Revaluation of answer books in any number of papers is permitted.
2. The fee for revaluation is ₹500/- per answer book.
3. The filled-in application form and prescribed fee should be submitted along with original copies of the mark sheet to the college exam branch before 08 July 2022.

**Issue of mark sheets** (*for BA/BSc 2nd & 4th regular students*)

The issue of mark sheets for BA/BSc 2nd & 4th Semester regular students will be notified when the classes commence for the odd semester session in July 2022.


**Progression to next odd semester** (*for BA/BSc 2nd & 4th regular students*)

As per the college examination rules and regulations:

- A student is eligible for progression to the BA/BSc 3rd Semester only if he/she has cleared at least 70% of the papers in BA/BSc 1st and 2nd semesters combined.
- A student is eligible for progression to the BA/BSc 5th Semester only if he/she has cleared at least 70% of the papers in BA/BSc 1st, 2nd, 3rd and 4th semesters combined.

Students who are not eligible to progress are to clear the required number of papers in the next odd end semester examinations (tentatively November 2022) and even end semester examinations (tentatively May 2023) for progression to the next odd semester in July 2023.
