

End Semester Examinations, May 2024

RESULT NOTIFICATION

BA/BSc 2nd, 4th, 6th Semesters

The provisional results of the End Semester Examinations (ESE), May 2024, for BA/BSc are hereby declared.

Issue of mark sheets (*for those who have finished BA/BSc programme*)

1. Original mark sheets (along with other relevant exam documents) for those who have finished the BA/BSc programme will be issued from 03 July 2024 onwards from the exam office during office hours.
2. A regular BA/BSc 6th Semester student is to submit the following while collecting the mark sheet:
 - (a) Clearance certificate from the Librarian
 - (b) A photocopy of his/her bank passbook clearly showing the bank details
3. A repeater of BA/BSc 2nd/4th Semester who have been declared passed in BA/BSc having cleared all six semesters is to submit the old BA/BSc 6th Semester mark sheet and pay ₹150/- for the new one.
4. For students who have been declared passed in BA/BSc having cleared all six semesters, provisional pass certificates will be issued by the college.
5. Any document has to be collected in person by the respective student and no request/authorisation letter will be entertained.

Correction of mark sheets (*for those being issued*)

While all care has been taken to ensure accuracy in the results published, errors, if any, will be rectified as per the examination rules and regulations of the college. Any mistake in the mark sheet must be reported to the exam section by 03 August 2024, after which due fees will be charged for any necessary correction.

Revaluation

1. Revaluation of answer books in any number of papers is permitted.
2. The fee for revaluation is ₹500/- per answer book.
3. The filled-in application form and prescribed fee should be submitted along with original copies of the mark sheet to the exam section before 18 July 2024.


Issue of mark sheets *(for BA/BSc 2nd & 4th regular students)*
