

## INSTRUCTIONS TO CANDIDATES APPLYING FOR RE-EVALUATION OF ANSWER BOOKS

### BA/BSc 1st Semester (FYUP) - Repeaters

1. Candidates who have appeared in the End Semester Examinations (UG), October 2025, are eligible to apply for re-evaluation of any number of their answer books in **theory papers**. *There is no provision for re-evaluation of answer books in practical examinations.*  
A student desiring re-evaluation must apply to the COE within the notified period.
2. The fee for re-evaluation is ₹ 500/- (Rupees five hundred only) per answer book.
3. Every application should be submitted by the candidate in the **prescribed form** along with the **prescribed fee** and a **self-attested printout of the Statement of Marks**.
4. Applications which are late or not in the prescribed form or which are found to be defective in any respect will not be entertained and will be summarily rejected.
5. The results of re-evaluation will be published on the college exam website within 30 days of the last date of application for re-evaluation. No interim enquiries of any kind will be entertained in this regard.
6. The score after re-evaluation will supersede the earlier score provided that downward revision of marks will be limited to the pass mark.
7. Students will be bound to accept any change in marks if it happens during re-evaluation.
8. No retrospective benefit such as award of gold medal, scholarship, fellowship, admission, etc. will accrue to a student as a result of re-evaluation.
9. If a score of the student after re-evaluation is higher than his/her original score by 20% or more of the maximum marks prescribed for the paper, his/her re-evaluation fee will be reimbursed.
10. **The college will not be responsible for any loss or damage or any inconvenience to the student consequent upon revision of marks.**
